

eTwinning club:

Aim: To continue providing opportunities for students to communicate and collaborate with foreign schools eTwinning clubs are organised during break time. This is on a voluntary basis and the students attend enthusiastically once a week. The students are participating in a project called ***The way we are*** with a class in Cherkasy – Ukraine. Partners from both countries upload information, videos, photos and communicate via the Twinspace which is part of the eTwinning platform. This is a very secure online space providing a safe environment for children to communicate live via chat or the video tool. Through eTwinning children are being exposed to 21st century skills.

The eTwinning club provides exciting and informal activities which contribute to their extra-curricular learning in a fun motivating way. The children are also learning to look up information themselves, present it to their friends and be more observant and critical of each other's work.
